Next Steps: *Moving Toward Simplified Accountability Structure*

Over the past couple of months, Marble Leadership has been talking to you about our movement toward the “Simplified Accountable Structure” or SAS. If approved, this structure will replace the current board and committee structure to perform the work of the church.

This is not a “done deal”. Leadership has been holding these important meetings to inform membership on the details and give members the opportunity to ask questions and learn about “SAS”.

There is a VOTE planned for Thursday, September 29th at 7:00pm. Members of Marble Memorial UMC will be asked to VOTE to accept or decline this leadership structure. (Attendees of Marble who are not members are not eligible to vote.)

NOW is the time to ask Pastor Matt or any Church Council member about SAS.

What’s next?

- READ Church emails coming to you (always) and pay special attention to the ones regarding SAS
- Attend and VOTE at the “Special Church Conference” on Thursday, September 29. This vote is to accept the move to SAS or not.
- If SAS is accepted, attend and VOTE on the new SAS Team at our yearly Church Conference on November 5 at Tecumseh UMC (details will be provided to you.)
